INCIDENT NARRATIVE

Dispatch- Dispatched to 111 Tremont City Road for a self storage facility on fire. Updated by dispatch that a female in unit 312 building number 16, knocked over a candle and caught the unit on fire.

On arrival, E-174 reported a large fire in storage building number 16 in the rear of the facility, at that time Chief 174 called for an Engine from SFRD and a full response from German Township. E-174 and Chief 1 used bolt cutters to gain entry through front gate.

E-174 deployed a 200' pre-connect 1.75" and started extinguishment on the Charlie side in unit 312, at this point, there were approximately 6 units fully involved, Springfield E-7 arrived and deployed a 200' pre-connect off E-174 to the Alpha side for extinguishment.

Tanker 74 and Tanker 78 supplied E-174 with water, German Township Engine crew assisted with extinguishment and opening up the building. Truck 1-74 assisted crews with extinguishment and deployed a 150' pre-connect bumper line off E-174 to the Charlie side.

Springfield Township requested for man power, E-72 and Ladder-58 arrived and assisted with overhaul and extinguishment. Truck 174 set up for ariel operations using a hydrant on Tremont Lane. Aerial operations done for about 20 minutes.

Crews operated on scene for 4.5 hours, used about 10,000 gallons of water, there were approximately 12 storage units that had heavy fire damage and 10 with heavy smoke, heat and water damage.

The reporting party is still on scene. (Phaedra Warner) she states she can't write a statement, but gave me and CCSO Deputy Reynolds a verbal statement of " she was in unit 312 looking for tools she needed for a job that day when she must have fell asleep and knocked over a candle she was using for light and it ignited the contents in this unit and it quickly spread". She states to me that she wasn't living in the storage unit.

The building owner is on scene and was given an update. Mutual Aid crew released and Moorefield units picked up equipment and checked for hotspots then returned to service.
